Parking Arrangements

To ensure compliance with **Health & Safety** regulations regarding free access to emergency vehicles there must be no vehicles left outside the Handicraft marquee.

Exhibitors wishing to drop off exhibits **MUST** purchase a car parking pass for **£7** which will entitle them to a ringside parking space. If the vehicle is removed from the field by 10.30am the parking fee will be refunded.

Any vehicle parked outside the marquee after 10.30am will be towed away at the owner's risk.

Rules

1. Entries must be received by **Thursday 1st August 2019** on the official entry form and **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FEE** and a large letter stamped self addressed envelope. **No late entries will be accepted.**
2. ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE STAGED BY 10.00am and may not be removed BEFORE 4.00pm, both under the direction of the staging committee. The tent will be open to the public when judging has finished at approximately 12.30pm.
3. Judging will commence at 10.00am.
4. All work must be the work of the exhibitor.
5. TWO ENTRIES allowed per person per class (except in the honey section).
6. **A large letter stamped self-addressed envelope must be enclosed with your entry form to receive your exhibitor's tickets.**
No Tickets issued on the day
7. All exhibits of eggs to be shown on plates provided by the society without doilies, mats or other decorations of any description.
8. Only two prizes to be awarded if less than four entries staged, but the judge has the power to award prizes at his or her discretion.
9. Classes with 20 or more entries the judge may award a 4th prize.
10. No exhibit is allowed which has previously been exhibited at Gosforth Show.
11. Every care will be taken to safeguard exhibitions, but the society undertakes no liability. Entries are accepted on this condition.
12. The society reserves the right to refuse any exhibits.
13. No soiled or worn articles will be accepted.
14. **All exhibitors must pay the entrance fee at the gate.**
15. Exhibitors with entry fee of £7 are given one free entrance ticket to the Show. But still need to buy a Car Parking Ticket.
16. No responsibility will be taken for any entry not picked up by exhibitor by 5.00pm.
17. Prize money not collected by 5.00pm will be forfeited.
18. In accordance with **GDPR** (General Data Protection Regulations) we ask you to 'Opt In' when completing the entry form to enable us to provide this service and future Gosforth Agricultural Society information to you. Please be assured that your information will not be offered to any third party and will be for the sole use as described here. Ennerdale Cake 3 pieces

280g plain flour
1 rounded teaspoon baking powder
170g caster sugar
170g butter
170g lard
1 large egg, beaten
Pinch of salt
Raspberry jam

Method

Set oven to 170oC - gas Mark 3

- 1. Grease and flour a shallow, 7 inch, square tin
- 2. Sieve the flour, baking powder and salt into a mixing bowl.
- 3. Take the butter and lard direct from the fridge, cut into small pieces and,

with the fingertips, mix lightly into the flour. Add the sugar and the beaten egg and mix well.

4. Turn out the mixture on to a well-floured board and divide in half, lightly flatten and mould one half, put into the tin and press evenly to the corners.
5. Spread with a layer of raspberry jam
6. Flatten and mould the other half of the mixture, place on top of the jam and press out evenly to the corners.
7. Press round the edges with a fork.

Bake for about 40-60 mins until light golden brown, leave in the tin to cool but cut into small squares while warm. Dredge the top with a little sieved icing sugar.

Plain Honey Cake – Class 132

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|------------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 5oz/150g Butter or Margarine | 2 eggs |
| 5oz/150g Soft Brown Sugar | 7oz/200g Self Raising Flour |
| 5oz/150g Clear Honey | 2 Tablespoons Milk |

1. Melt butter or margarine with sugar, honey and milk over a low heat.
2. Stir in the eggs and flour.
3. Bake in a round 7" diameter cake tin for 45 minutes at 350°f /180°c / Gas Mark 4.

Fruit Honey Cake – Class 133

Ingredients

6oz/175g Butter or margarine
3oz/75g Runny Honey
plus 1 tbsp Runny Honey
3oz/75g Soft Brown Sugar
8oz/225g Self Raising flour
8oz/225g Mixed Dried Fruit
3 Eggs
1tsp Baking Powder
1tsp Mixed Spice
½ tsp Grated Nutmeg

Method

Set Oven temperature to 170oC.
Grease or line 2lb loaf tin.
Cream together the butter, or margarine, with honey and sugar.
Sift together the flour, baking powder and spices.
Mix the eggs with a fork.
Add eggs and flour alternately to the creamed mixture, beating well between each addition. Add the fruit and mix well.
Turn into the lined loaf tin and bake for approx 55 to 65 mins.
Once cooked, drizzle the extra tablespoon of honey over the still warm cake.
Leave to cool in the tin.
