Rules

PLEASE NOTE YOUR EXHIBITOR NUMBERS SHOULD BE COLLECTED FROM THE HORTICULTURAL SECRETARY IN THE TENT ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW

1. Fees are stated on entry form
2. Entries close on Thursday 1st August 2019.
3. Entries must be staged by 10.00 a.m. under the direction of the Stewards. Only the Judges and Committee are allowed in the tent during judging.
4. The tent will be open to the public at 12.30 p.m. or after the judging whichever is the later.
5. No exhibit may be removed before 4.00 p.m.
6. No exhibitor may have more than two entries per class.
7. All exhibits (except in Classes 1-5 and 9-15 ie for Children and Floral Art) must have been grown by the Exhibitor.
8. All vases, containers, plates, trays and accessories, etc. must be provided by the Exhibitor, and be his/her responsibility.
9. Any protest must be made to the Tent Secretary in writing before 4.00 p.m. with a fee of 50p which will be forfeited if the protest is not upheld.
10. Any prize may be withheld if the Judges consider the exhibits unworthy of the prize. The Judges decision is final
11. Prize winners should obtain prizes from the Tent Secretary, except for the trophies, presented in the Horticultural Tent at 2.30 p.m.
12. Exhibits not removed by 4.30 p.m. unless noted with "not for Auction" cards, will be assumed not to be required by the exhibitor. Such produce and any similar gifts, which will be most welcome, will be auctioned for the show's funds.
13. "Not for Auction" cards may be obtained from the Tent Secretary.
14. In the event of a tie for prizes for "Most Points", the award will be decided by the greater number of firsts, then seconds and then, if the points are entirely equal, by the Judges.
15. The Committee reserves the right to appoint a sub-committee to visit the garden or allotment of an Exhibitor.
16. Where possible, exhibits should be named. In case of a tie, preference will be given to a named variety.

17. All Exhibitors with less than £7 entry fee to pay entrance fee at the Gate. Those with more than £7 entry fee will receive a pass to be given up at the Gate, but this is not a car pass.

Age: under 15 years on Show day (age to be stated on Entry Form)

A Special prize will be presented for the Most Points in the Children's Classes

1. Picture made with pressed flowers/grasses, max size A4
2. A tree grown from seed (not necessarily in its first year)
3. Cactus in a pot – pot not to exceed 6"
4. An arrangement of flowers in a mug
5. Herb or herbs grown in a pot/container max size 8" pot
6. A garden on a plate
7. Funny shaped fruit or vegetable
8. An animal made from fruit and/or vegetables

Floral Art

The Steelfield Cup will be awarded for the most points in Floral Art

9. An arrangement with five blooms only plus foliage – max 9"
10. Arrangement in a can, with flowers/foliage/accessories – max 12" width
11. Arrangement of flowers, foliage, accessories in a basket. 2ft width given.
12. Miniature arrange, flowers, foliage and accessories in an egg cup 4"x4"x9" high.
13. Arrangement of flowers/foliage from own garden. 18" width max
14. A celebration of christmas themed arrangement, flowers/foliage/accessories. 2ft width given.
15. Buttonholes, mounted on card or base board 8"x4" max.

16. Vase of 3 Specimen Dahlias (any size)
17. Vase of 3 Cactus Dahlias (any size)

Roses

- 18. Vase of 1 cluster blooms
- 19. Vase of 1 specimen bloom

Chrysanthemums

- 20. Vase of 3 stems Chrysanthemum blooms, any variety
- 21. Vase of 3 stems of Spray Chrysanthemums, any variety

Gladioli

- 22. Vase of 3 Gladioli – any variety
- 23. Vase of 1 Gladioli – any variety

Sweet Peas

The Norman Curbishley Cup for most points in Sweet Peas

- 24. Sweet Peas, one vase, 9 stems any variety

Other Flowers

- 26. Vase of annuals – same variety, any number (no variety listed in other classes)

- 30. 4 Pansies/violas on a board or tray

Pot Plants

(Please note all pot plants to be placed on tray or saucer)

- 31. Begonia – any

- 33. An annual grown from seed

- 35. Succulents/Cacti, one or more of the same variety, one pot
- 36. Succulent/Cacti Garden, three or more any variety, container not to exceed 18"
- 37. Any other pot plant
- 38. Window Box: size not to exceed 24" with 3 or more varieties of plants.
- 39. An alpine plant or plants max 8" pot
